Part of the Crystal Surfaces collection, the sheet—which can be fabricated in a flat or curved form—is suitable for interior wall and lighting applications. The latter can be illuminated from behind with LEDs or above for a sparkling effect.

White Oak Groove is a straight-grain wood veneer with a textured surface that's prefinished with a laminate backer. The covering is made using engineered wood, a process that can produce the look and feel of most species using trees from sustainably managed, controlled and traceable forest sources. Recommended for interior use on vertical and light-duty horizontal surfaces.
